Of late, we have been receiving bounces from your mail servers even though our client does want to receive these emails. We would appreciate your assistance in whitelisting our mail server domain or IP addresses.

Below are the addresses you can whitelist if you're having trouble delivering email from our software to your own network. Depending on your situation, you can whitelist sending domains or IP addresses.

Instead of whitelisting all of our sending IP addresses, you can whitelist our domains. They currently include [cmail1.com](http://cmail1.com) through to [cmail20.com](http://cmail20.com)
